## Meetings at the Grand Junction Masonic Center During the Pandemic

Until the current COVID-19 pandemic is over the Grand Valley Event Center (GVEC) will be requiring each renter group to adhere to applicable State and Mesa Country COVID-19 Orders, including distancing, masking and sanitizing requirements.

GVEC will supply sanitizing materials, post required notices at entrances and throughout the building, and monitor compliance by periodic observation during events. As of November 24, 2020, GVEC is operating the facility under the Mesa County Variance Protection/5 Star Program. Renters will be required to comply with the following:

1. Each renter will designate a responsible adult to monitor each person entering:

a. Is properly masked with a non-medical cloth face covering over the nose and mouth.

b. Is tested for fever with a supplied thermometer.

c. Does not appear to demonstrate dry cough, shortness of breath,

difficulty breathing, fatigue, or a recent loss of taste or smell.

Those persons so affected will be sent home.

d. Established seating and table spacing is enforced.

2. Renters will ensure that the number of people attending their event is limited to no more that 50% of normal room capacity and that no more than 100 people are present in confined indoor spaces in the entire building.

3. Established seating and table spacing will not altered and only the number of people for which seating is available will be admitted – no standing room space allowed.

4. Renters will disinfect high-touch surfaces in rented areas as well as items shared between individuals. Single use rather than self-service equipment or utensils will be used.

5. If alcohol is permitted, service must end no later than 10 pm.

6. Dancing, music and live performances will not be allowed.
