Sickness & Distress

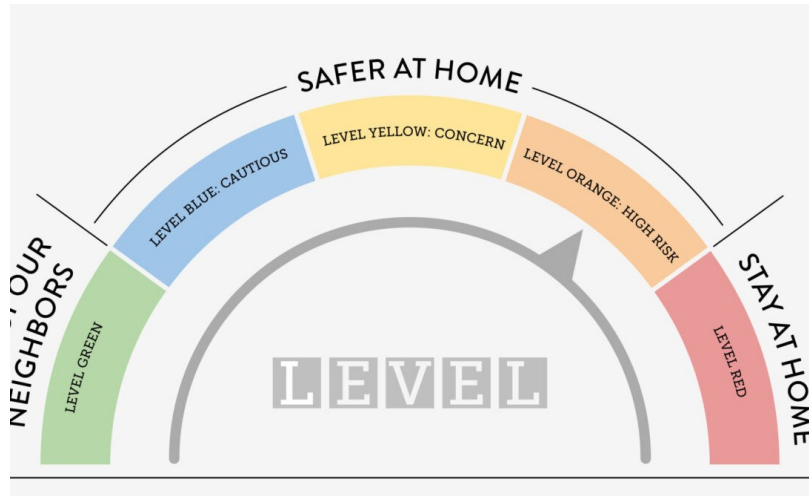
- Brother Naaman Morehouse who fell and broke his hip is out of the recovery center and back home.

COVID-19 Revisited

Brethren: Now is a good time to update you on the status of current COVID-19 requirements for Masonic meetings and functions. On March 16th the Grand Master ordered a suspension of our meetings and activities of, or sponsored by, any Masonic body in Colorado. That order was lifted on June 1st provided that Lodges and Temple Associations should “continuously read and strictly adhere to” state, county and municipal regulations, orders and variances.

The Grand Junction Temple Association, after posting the required notices and distributing sanitizing materials throughout the building, submitted a business plan and received County Health Department approval to hold meetings and other gatherings subject to masking, distancing and capacity requirements contained in the Mesa County Phase 2 Order.

With the rise in reported COVID cases in the County the Health Department, on November 6th amended its Phase 2 Order with a Phase 1 Safer At Home Level Orange: High Risk designation. (See chart). Given the size of Masonic gatherings this should not affect the way our lodges and the Masonic Center plan to use the facility. So, right now Masonic organizations are, and will, continue to hold meetings and events in the building and the Center will continue to rent the building to outside groups.

To our members we say: Wear A Mask At All Times (Except When Seated At Meals); Keep at Least 6 Feet Away From Others; and Don't Come If You Are Ill, Have COVID-19 Symptoms, Or Are In 2 Or More Risk Categories.

Be safe this will pass.
